What is the competition?

The challenge aims to make the young students understand the importance of technology and give them a platform, where they can be innovation creators. In brief, the challenge urges Scouts to identify problems in and around them and then create solutions using technology.

In this process, Scouts will be supported with online learning content, Virtual camps and mentoring by tech experts. The aim of this challenge is to give young members of the scout community of our country a platform and opportunity to become solution creators for the problems they see around them and their communities. This initiative will allow the scouts to gain a basic understanding of "better and more sustainable future for all" by teaching Ideation - idea generation, 2 Do-It-Yourself (DIY) concepts, Design thinking, etc.

Key Features

The challenge will be implemented at national level - open to all Scouts/Guides/Rovers/Ranger from age 13 to 25 across the country.

There will be 8 core theme areas on which scouts can share their ideas which are mentioned below.

Theme Areas:

There are 8 Main Core theme areas.

Health	Education	Environment
Agriculture	Infrastructure	Disability
Digital literacy	Social Welfare	

There will be 2 categories:

i. Scouts/Guides (13yrs to 17 yrs)

ii. Young Adults (18yrs to 25 yrs)

There will be three phases in the competition.

Timeline:

Starting Registration and entries from	1st Sept 2020
Ideation Closes	- 20th Sept 2020
Announcement of Ideation results	- 30th Sept 2020
Boot Camp	- 1st to 15th Oct 2020
Final Exhibition	- 25th Nov 2020

i. Phase – 1 (Ideation):

Interested Scouts and Guides should share online videos and submit their proposed solutions/ideas in an online format as a video. Top 100 ideas which will create an impact in the society will be shortlisted and will be called for a boot camp.

ii. Phase – 2 (Boot Camp):

All the students will undergo a training, which will be of a series of webinars, where the experts of the specified topics will be conducting for 3 days using a virtual platform and top projects will be selected for the next round with respect to judging criteria's.

iii. Phase – 3 (Exhibition):

The selected participants from across the country will be given 20 days after the 3 day training course. In these 20 days they need to work on the solution to make their idea a reality by making a working model.

The Top 25 will be called on a virtual platform where they need to explain their idea and should showcase their working model in the exhibition.

What the students should do?

1. The students are expected to identify problems around them in their community.
2. Think of cost effective and innovative solutions.
3. Upload a 90 second idea video sharing their suggestions, plans and ideas on the mentioned website only.
4. The top 2 participants in each category who have the highest number of views and likes in the social media will be having direct entry to round 2.

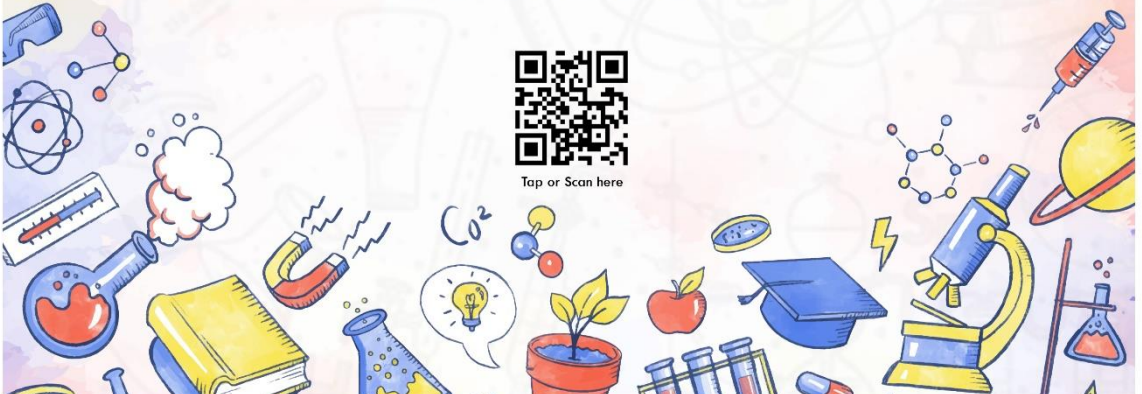
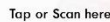
